All event attendees should enter through the marked entrances shown on the venue map.




TICKETING

The event day box office is open from 2pm.

For your own safety, please remember that chairs are not permitted into the venue, including blankets, camping chairs, shooting sticks and rollators or walking sticks with seats. TRAVEL & TRANSPORT INFORMATION

There is no parking at the venue - please make use of public parking and transport detailed in the map opposite (charges may apply). Disabled badge holders may park free of charge in any council car park or on-street parking bay.

Please take note of the road closures that will be in place over the weekend, and please be aware of any local parking restrictions eg. in City Quay.

Dundee Train Station is only a 5 minute walk from Slessor Gardens, and offers many routes throughout the country. If using this service it is advised to give yourselves extra time and book your tickets in advance.

Please be aware that City Centre bus stops will be relocated temporarily during the concert.

ON SITE FACILITIES

Food and Drink

No food or drink can be brought onto the site unless dietary restrictions are in place (a dietary card is required). There will be ample concessions for food and drinks within the concert site.

You are permitted to bring an empty, reusable water bottle (this **must** be empty on arrival and can be filled at water refill points) or sealed plastic bottle (maximum size of 500ml). On sites where there are no refill points, water will be available from the bars. Any alcohol purchased at any of the bars within the venue must be consumed onsite and not taken out of the designated event area. In keeping with Licensing Laws, there will be a Challenge 25 Policy in place for all alcohol sales. Please drink responsibly.

Smoking Policy

Smoking is permitted in the standing areas of the venue, however please be considerate of those around you.

Drug Use

There is a zero-tolerance response to illegal drugs and New Psychoactive Substances (NPS). Any person found in possession of illegal drugs or NPS will be passed to the relevant authorities. The terms and conditions of entry state: "You may be searched at the entrance. Any items which the organisers consider may be used in an illegal or offensive manner will be confiscated. Persons suspected of carrying out illegal and/or offensive activities onsite may be searched." Anyone caught with illegal substances will have their ticket made invalid, no refunds will be given.

First Aid

A medical team will be in attendance during our events. Should you or anyone in your party require first aid, please notify the nearest steward or event official who will deal with your request.

What to do in an Emergency

There are stewards and event staff on duty at every concert. Locate a member of staff for any emergencies, who will be able to assist or locate the correct assistance. If you need to contact the Police to report a non-emergency crime or to provide information on a crime while at the festival, please call 101. If a serious or life-threatening crime is being committed, please contact a member of staff immediately. If in the unlikely event you cannot find someone, please call 999.
